Terms & Conditions

For Camping

1. Any person intending to stay on the grounds overnight must pay a camping fee to the Show Society.
2. All vehicles camping overnight on the showgrounds are required to display a camping sticker in the front left hand corner of the windscreen.
3. **All power cords must be tested and tagged** (6 or 12 months in accordance with AS/NZS 3000:2000 Electrical Installations).
 - An electrician will be available on the showgrounds on Saturday morning for testing and tagging, for a fee to be paid by the site holder.
 - **Extension cords are to be a maximum length of 50 metres.**
4. **Gas cooking facilities in all caravans, fl oats, trucks require suitable fire extinguishers to be tested and tagged, prior to arrival (eg CO2, water, chemical).**
5. All gas bottles: to be in good condition and less than 10 years old to be outside the vehicle/structure
 - not to block any exit
 - on a level non-combustible surface secured in an upright position
 - in a well ventilated location
 - with safety relief valve facing away from vehicle/structure
 - in a clear area from ignition sources
6. Contravention of any of the conditions may mean removal from the showgrounds.
