1. Best Rural Ute-Well accessorized, nudge bar/bullbar, few stickers, clean, shiny, new or old, fastidiously looked after but still driven on dirt and paved roads.
2. Best Genuine B&S Ute - Looking for the ute that typifies the Auslaian B&S ute. Clean enough but not that clean that you won't climb into the back after partying hard. Bullbar, aerials, side skirts/stone guards, spotlights, CB, UHF, side lights, etc. Doesn't have to be spotless.
3. Best B&S Styled-This is for the ute that looks the goods-Big shiny bullbar, side skirts/stone guards, spotlights, CB, UHF, side lights etc. Almost a show/ute but with the unmistakable Australian B&S theme
4. Best Street: Immaculate paint (some stone chips acceptable as proof of driving), interior clean and tidy, tray perhaps decked out, and nice wheels. All round tidy Ute.
5. Best 4wd - Best fitted out 4wd for genuine 4wd off roading. Getting into trouble, being able to survive while in that trouble then getting out and returning to civilization is the go here (winch, fridge, first aid kit, bull bar, spotlights, roof racks, etc).
6. Most practical/Best Tradies. Best fitted out to do the job, be it farm, home or tradie use
7. Best Country B&S Chicks Ute: Ute showing evidence of a females touch (proof of registration may be asked for) within the judging parameters for best Country/B&S.
8. Best Chicks Street Ute: - showing evidence of a females touch (proof of registration may be asked for) within the judging parameters of Street.
9. Classic/Vintage Pre 1975 Ute either restored to original or still original.
10. Best other: For all those that don't follow the crowd. Mopar, Nissan, Toyota, Suzuki and all the other brands out there that are just a little bit different.
11. Best Ford: One just for the Blue Oval brigade! The best Ford on the day will win this one whether it be a B&S ute, a tradies, 4wd or a street ute.
12. Best Holden: For fans of the Lion only! Could be a street ute, could be a B&S ute or any of the other types that gets this one.
13. Best Feral: Roughest most beat up Ute. Must still run, be registered and driven in on the day. Proof of registration may be required.
14. Best overall display: Conveying this years show theme. Includes the way the flags tie in with the overall look of the Ute as well as lights and general presentation such as decorations in cab and tray.
15. Policeman's choice: Dancing with fire! This will be judged by an officer of the law and will be his/her Ute of choice. May come back to roadworthiness.
16. Most Trucked up: The closest a Ute can get to being a truck without actually being a truck. Exhaust stacks etc a definite advantage.
17. Most likely to be pulled over: For the one (as judged by our judges) most likely, out of all the utes present to be pulled over by the constabulary. May not be the most feral or the loudest etc, maybe just the most radical.
18. Exhaust sound off, 4, 6 & 8: Measured using a Db meter and a judges ear. No open exhausts. Run it as you bring it.

19. Furthest travelled: From garaged address and checked with a GPS. Please be honest.
20. Encouragement award-Street and Country/B&S: This is for the people who are just getting started. Be honest about the number of shows entered and awards won.

Grand Champion Ute: Winner judged from winners of categories above other than loudest exhaust, most likely to be pulled over and furthest travelled.
